1. Where will my interview be taking place?

• Dates: March 03-17, 2024

• Location: Via Zoom

2. How long will I interview with my interviewers?

• Interview: 15 minutes

• Feedback and Questions: 15 minutes

3. What should I wear to my interview? Please appear in courtroom attire.

4. How early should I arrive to my interview?

Please arrive 5 minutes early and wait in the waiting room via zoom to make sure you are accounted for as to the interview.

5. What if I am late to the interview. If you are more than 10 minutes late, you will forfeit your interview.

Interview Tips and Tricks

- 1. Have at least one question for the interviewers.
- 2. Be at least 5 minutes early.
- 3. Be dressed appropriately.
- 4. Remember that this is an interview, and we are trying to get to know you, please be yourself.
- 5. Understand that there are a limited number of slots, so you are competing for placement.
- 6. Be cheerful and excited to interview for the program.
- 7. If you have found employment, please notify the program chair so that we will not interview you for placement- be mindful of other students applying.
- 8. Be honest during the interview.
